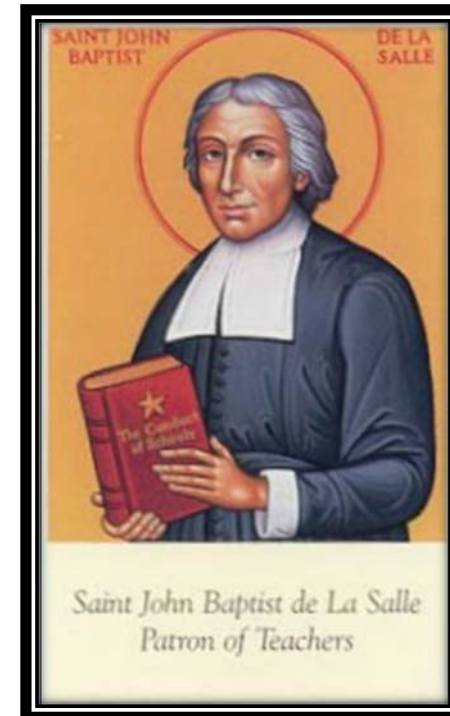

HOLY FACE REPARATION CROSSES.

In a few weeks time, there will be available for the members of the Holy Face Archconfraternity- Holy Face crosses of Reparation which are beautiful. They will be free. More details soon.

Finally, Our Lord told me that He desired each member of the Association to wear a special Cross, and that on one side of this Cross should be engraved the words, '**Blessed be the Name of God,**' (*Sit Nomen Domini Benedictum*) and on the reverse side should be the words, '**Begone Satan!**' (*Vade Retro Satana!*) To all those wearing this Holy Cross Our Lord promised a special resourcefulness to conquer the demon of blasphemy, adding that every time one hears a curse, he should repeat the two short inscriptions written on each side of the Cross, and he will thus overcome the evil one and render glory to God."

HOW TO MAKE YOU DONATIONS GO 33% FURTHER

Receipts for last year's donation are available at the entrance to the chapel for all benefactors who have requested them by way of donation envelopes. If any faithful require a donation receipt for the past year, please let the priest in charge of your chapel know as soon as possible so that one will be organised. All faithful should be advised that their annual donations can attract a 33% annual return from the Inland Revenue when, as tax payers, their donations are recorded by the church and an official donations receipts is issued annually. So if a benefactors donations \$3000 annually, they can get back \$1000 annually from the government for their donations. Why let they government keep the money when the works of the Holy Church are in such great need of your support?

For this reason the SSPX in NZ would like to encourage all faithful to obtain the 33% rebate on donations to help towards the funding of a project we have underway. The latest project is a much needed playground facility for the Primary school which will cost around \$20,000. If most faithful take the time to obtain from the government the 33% return mentioned above, and the pass it on to the SSPX, this project will be fully realisable. Please help us if you can!
