COMMENTS ON THE WAY OF THE CROSS

Abbot Dom Marmion had a great devotion to The Way of The Cross. He prayed this exercise every day. He carried with him always a little pocket book on the Way of the Cross and composed of fourteen metal plaques, folding one upon another, upon which were engraved the scenes of The Passion. His Holy Death came on the 30th January 1923.

The passion consists of the “Holy of Holies” The immediate preparation which the Saviour made before His oblation as High Priest upon Calvary was to bear His Cross from the Pretorium to Golgotha, overwhelmed by sufferings. Despised and insulted. The Blessed Virgin Mary and the first Christians evidently more than once retraced this path, shedding tears of compassion at the places sanctified by the sufferings of the Man-God.

The contemplation of the sorrows of Jesus is sovereignly fruitful for souls: no detail is negligible in the Passion of Christ, the son of God, the object of His Father’s complacency. Jesus especially manifests His virtues in the course of His Passion. Ever living, he produces within us the perfection that we contemplate in His immolation. Because the Passion of Jesus is his essential work, nearly all the details of it were foretold. There is no other mystery of Jesus whereof the circumstances were announced with so much care by the psalmist and Prophets. And when we read in the Gospel the account of the Passion, we are struck by the attention that Christ Jesus shows to “fulfil” what had been announced concerning Him. If He permits the presence of the traitor at the Last Supper, it is “that the Scripture may be fulfilled”. With every action Jesus does, the Father is well pleased. He contemplates His Son with Love, not only on Thabor, when Christ is in the splendour of His glory, but likewise when Pilate shows Him to the multitude, crowned with thorns, and became the outcast of humanity; in the ignominies of His Passion as well as in the splendours of The Transfiguration:

Moreover, we should love to meditate upon the Passion because therein Christ makes His virtues shine forth with such brilliance. He possesses every virtue within His soul, but the occasions of manifesting them especially arise in His Passion. His immense love for His Father, His charity for mankind, hatred of sin, forgiveness of injuries, patience, meekness, fortitude, obedience to lawful authority, compassion, all these virtues shine out in a heroic manner in these days of sorrow.

When we contemplate Jesus in His Passion, we see the Exemplar of our life, the model-admirable and accessible at the same time-of those virtues of compunction, abnegation, patience, resignation, abandonment to God’s will, charity, meekness, which we ought to practise so as to become like unto our Divine Head: This is why, if every day, during a few moments, interrupting your work, laying aside your preoccupations and choosing your heart to all outward things, you accompany the Man-God along the road to Calvary, with faith, humility and love, with the true desire of imitating the virtues that He manifests in His Passion, be assured that your souls will receive choice graces which will transform them little by little into the likeness of Jesus and of Jesus Crucified.
